Special Program

Speaker: Jeff Seevers from Titebond presented an informative display of the Titebond glue product line. He can be contacted at 1-800-347-GLUE.

Some notes: Titebond I (RED) was first produced in 1952; Titebond II (BLUE) was distributed for Exterior use in 1991, and Titebond III (GREEN) was developed in 2004 as a waterproof glue. These three glues are rubber based. Other glues mentioned were Molding and Trim Glue which dries fast and clear, and Hide Glue (from 1935) which is an animal protein base and can be dissolved easily for repairs. Watch the

expiration date on these glues as they can go bad and not appear to be bad. Code ID example: 5E where 5 means 2005 and E means the month May (where Jan = A)
