Bill Blackburn did a presentation on tool sharpening techniques and sharpening stones. Bill is an instructor at Woodcraft in Stanton, CA. Bill teaches a class entitled "Sharpening Chisels & Plane Irons with Bill Blackburn". Bill showed us how to put the perfect edge on your tools using both sharpening machines and water stones. Bill recommended using Waterstones versus Oilstones. Recommended a set of waterstones by SHAPTON as a very good way to keep your tools sharp. Cost is about \$350 for a set including grits from 1000 to 8000. A diamond Stone flattening tool is an extra \$300.
